WEIGH-INS & REGISTRATION: Weigh-ins and registration will take place between 1 pm and 8 pm on Friday November 20, 2009 at the host hotel for the event. Hotel information will be published on the website in July 2009. Each team will register and weigh in together. **ATHLETES WILL WEIGH-IN WEARING A SINGLET.**

PARKING: Parking is free for the event.

ADMISSION: Admission to the event will be \$10.

COOLERS: TEAM COOLERS WILL BE RESTRICTED TO THE HOSPITALITY ROOM. THERE IS A \$30 COOLER FEE. ABSOLUTELY NO OUTSIDE FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THROUGH THE GENERAL ADMISSION GATE.

COACHS' MEETING: The coach's meeting will be held at event venue at 8:15am on Saturday November 21.

COMPETITION: Opening ceremonies will be held at 8:45 am on Saturday, November 21, 2009, competition will begin following opening ceremonies. **RULES:** Rules will be according to the USA Wrestling Handbook, the USA National Codebook and the National High School Rulebook.

Girls' Dual Team Information

The weight classes for the event are: 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 66, 70, 74, 81, 88, 97, 105, 114, 125, 136, 136+ (30lbs max difference). Tenths will be dropped at weigh-ins to accommodate scale differences. Competitors in weight classes 66 – 136+ must have been born in 1994 or after, **AND** be enrolled in middle school (or junior high), 6th through 8th Grade. Competitors that meet this age and grade criteria are **PROHIBITED** from competing in weight classes lower than 66lbs. Wrestlers younger or in lower grades than those stipulated in the upper weight class criteria may wrestle in weight classes 66 – 136+ with the signed permission of the parent/guardian.

Each Participant should bring proof of age and grade with them to the event. A team shall consist of up to 16 weight classes, 4 alternates, and 1 table worker.

EACH TEAM WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO PROVIDE ONE TIMER OR ONE SCORER FOR EACH OF THEIR TEAM'S DUAL MEETS.

AMONG THOSE TIED, CRITERIA IN CASE OF TWO OR MORE TEAMS ENDING WITH IDENTICAL

RECORDS: (in a situation of a three-way tie, once the three-way tie is broken to two teams revert to the following process beginning with head-to-head.)

1. Head-to-head competition
2. Greatest number of team points
3. Greatest number of individual wins
4. Greatest number of falls
5. Greatest number of technical falls
6. Greatest number of major decisions
7. Greatest number of offensive points scored by all athletes during the head-to-head competition

TIE BREAKERS FOR ALL DUAL MEETS AMONG THOSE TIED:

1. The team who has been penalized the least for Flagrant or Unsportsmanlike conduct
2. The team having won the greatest number of individual matches
3. The team who has accumulated the greater amount of 6 point wins
4. The team having the greater number of technical falls
5. The team having the greater number of major decisions
6. The team having the greater number of points for near-falls
7. The team having the greater number of takedowns
8. The team having the greater number of escapes
9. It's a tie

AWARDS: Top four teams will receive trophies. Individual awards will be presented based upon win/loss criteria. MOW and Sportsmanship award will be presented to athletes. Most Outstanding Coach and Coaches' Sportsmanship Award will be presented.
