Elementary School Dual Team Information

The weight classes for the event are: 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 100, 108, 116, 125, and HWT. Tenths will be dropped at weigh-ins to accommodate scale differences. Competitors must have been born in 1997 or after, **AND** be enrolled in elementary school, kindergarten through 6th Grade. Each Participant should bring proof of age and grade with them to the event. A team shall consist of up to: 16 weight classes, 4 alternates, and 1 table worker.

EACH TEAM WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO PROVIDE ONE TIMER OR ONE SCORER FOR EACH

ENTRY FEE: \$350

Middle School Dual Team Information

The weight classes for the event are: 77, 84, 91, 98, 105, 112, 120, 128, 136, 144, 152, 160, 175, 190, 210, and HWT. Tenths will be dropped at weigh-ins to accommodate scale differences. Competitors must have been born in 1994 or after, **AND** be enrolled in middle school (or junior high), 7th through 8th Grade. Each Participant should bring proof of age and grade with them to the event. A team shall consist of up to 16 weight classes, 4 alternates, and 1 table worker.

EACH TEAM WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO PROVIDE ONE TIMER OR ONE SCORER FOR EACH OF THEIR TEAM'S DUAL MEETS.

Girls' Dual Team Information

The weight classes for the event are: 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 66, 70, 74, 81, 88, 97, 105, 114, 125, 136, 136+ (30lbs max difference). Tenths will be dropped at weigh-ins to accommodate scale differences. Competitors in weight classes 66 – 136+ must have been born in 1994 or after, **AND** be enrolled in middle school (or junior high), 6th through 8th Grade. Competitors that meet this age and grade criteria are **PROHIBITED** from competing in weight classes lower than 66lbs. Wrestlers younger or in lower grades than those stipulated in the upper weight class criteria may wrestle in weight classes 66 – 136+ with the signed permission of the parent/guardian.
